Doddinghurst: All Saints Church

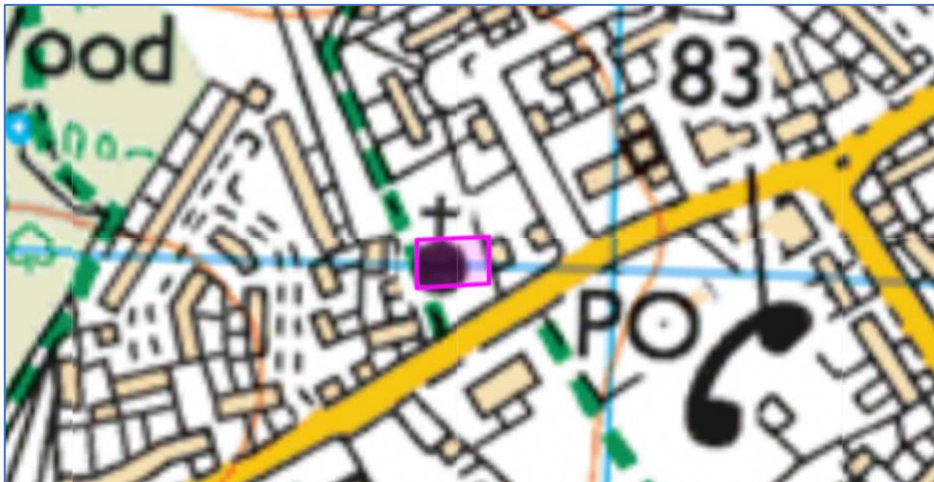
Site location: entrance off Church Lane, Doddinghurst

Status: Publicly accessible

Summary of the geological interest:

The external walls contain many different rock types of geological interest and several fossils. The geology of All Saints Church is described in an article in the Essex Field Club Newsletter of May 2016 (George 2016), which has colour photographs of some of the stones and fossils. The Victorian vestry is of particular interest.



Site Assessment. Local Geological Sites (LoGS) in Essex are assessed using criteria based on DEFRA guidance. This site has been assessed and qualifies under these criteria. An assessment form is used which asks key questions under four value categories: scientific, educational, historical and aesthetic.
